

7th Operation Coordination Unit Meeting

Identification of the Pilot Sites

Regarding the developments on the identification of pilot sites, a meeting was held with the General Directorate of Environmental Management at the premises of the Ministry on 13.07.2020.

Technical Assistance Team started to meet with the public institutions to identify two pilot sites for remediation studies to be operated within the scope of the project. TAT continues the researches on potential sites and visits public institutions in their premises to inform about the project. Following the identification of the sites contaminated with persistent organic pollutants, technical specifications for these sites will be finalized by the PRAG/FIDIC Expert. Pilot remediation works are planned to be started by the end of September 2020 and will be a reference to the future remediation works in the country and create public awareness on Persistent Organic Pollutants.

The Meeting on Preparation of Technical Specifications was held on 29.07.2020.

PRAG/FIDIC Expert who will work on the preparation of the Technical Specifications for the works to be operated on the pilot sites, started his duty as of July 2020. The details on Technical Specification preparation were discussed during this meeting organized with the Contracting Authority, Ministry of Environment and Urbanisation, General Directorate of European Union and Foreign Relations.



Training Needs Assessment

Training Needs Assessment Survey was sent to provincial directorates of the Ministry of Environment and Urbanisation. Training Needs Assessment Report is planned to be finalized in August 2020 according to the responses received from the participants.
